Class Summary	Korean pronunciation (vowels and consonants) will be studied through different listening content about greetings, places, shopping, everyday life, birthdays, food, family, promises and appointments, etc.		
Class Purpose	The purpose of this class is to develop an ability to listen to and understand Korean with a Level 1 base of vocabulary and expressions, and with a combined educational program of speaking-listening-reading-writing, communicate using the Korean language.		
Class Goal	The goal of this class is to be able to develop the ability to listen to and understand basic and necessary Korean phrases that are used in daily life.		
Class Attributes	Learning materials and appropriate activities before, during and after listening lessons will develop a good sense of understanding and memory.
