Class Summary	Develop accurate speaking and pronunciation of the Korean alphabet (vowels and consonants) and the accurate pronunciation of practical words and simple greetings. They will also be acquainted with and study vocabulary, grammar, and short expressions through lessons of greetings, places, buying things, everyday life, birthdays, food, family, promises and appointments, etc.			
Class Purpose	The purpose of this class is to acquaint foreign students with Korean pronunciation and to be able to develop an ability to use the language in real life situations with Korean Vocabulary and phrases learned in Level 1.			
Class Goal	The goal of this class is to be able to understand and be able to speak and express in daily life necessary and basic Korean words and/or phrases by studying topics that are familiar to the student.			
Class Attributes	The class will utilize diverse learning materials to help for better understanding and memorizing. Content will be systematic and accurate, and there will be repeated practicing of the lessons to establish fluency. Through this class, an ability to apply language learned in realistic conversational situations will be established.
